Missionary Prayer Letter – November – December 2022

The Book of Joshua begins with a magnificent promise by God to Joshua : “I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life.” (Joshua 1:3-5)

History tells us that the land conquered by the Israelites was less than 10% of what God had promised them.

1400 years later, Jesus gave His disciples the Great Commandment before His ascension to Heaven: “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...” (Matthew 28:19). The reality is that the number of born-again Christians is less than 10% of the world population.

The Old Testament Israel fell short of God's expectation by a wide margin. So is the New Testament Church.

The world is on fire. Our Lord is coming back soon. Let us hold fast to God’s promise in taking the good news of Christ to the suffering nations.

Prayer Items

1. Visa Application

We have begun the visa application process. It may take a few months to know the result. Please pray that our visa applications are successful.

2. Supporting churches

Presently nine EFCC churches have agreed to be our “sending church” or “supporting church”. We praise for Lord for them, and hope that more local churches will join this worthwhile endeavor.

3. Funding

Each country will be supporting the missionaries they send to Taiwan, as well as contributing towards a “common pool” fund to cover expenditures such as building rental, equipment purchases and local staff hiring. The total fund raising target for Hong Kong is \$1.8 million (HKD) every year. Please pray for God’s provision.

4. Strategies and Plans

Pray that the Lord will give us the wisdom to find effective ways to reach out to the community, through bilingual gatherings, cultural activities, children programs, coffee house and other services.

5. Ministry Roles

Pray that the Lord will raise missionaries for this work, including those whose native language is English. In addition to pastors and evangelists, we need workers in the fields of administration, languages tutoring, coffee house management as well as family and children services.
